Packing List

What to Bring

Clothes

- ☐ shorts, t-shirts, jeans, etc.
- ☐ bring clothes/shoes that can get dirty
- ☐ bring some nicer clothes for worship (shorts are fine)
- ☐ swimsuit/towel
girls: must be 1-piece or bring a dark shirt to wear over 2-piece
- ☐ sandals
- ☐ tennis shoes (don't bring only sandals)

Other

- ☐ Bible
- ☐ sleeping bag/linens (twin-sized mattress)
- ☐ pillow
- ☐ flashlight (important!)
- ☐ spending money (\$20-\$25)

Toiletries

- ☐ toothbrush/toothpaste
- ☐ shampoo/soap
- ☐ towels (bring separate towels for showers and swimming)
- ☐ bug spray
- ☐ sunscreen

Worth it?

- ☐ camera
- ☐ hearing-aids
- ☐ cell phone
- ☐ ipad/tablet
- ☐ other electronics or valuables

What **NOT** to Bring

- drugs of any kind (including alcohol or tobacco)
- fireworks, dynamite, TNT, bombs, cannons, or any kind of explosives
- lighters or matches
- shaving cream (unless used for shaving)
- inappropriate magazines, books, movies, or music
- pink Flamingos
- knives, guns, or any kind of weapon
